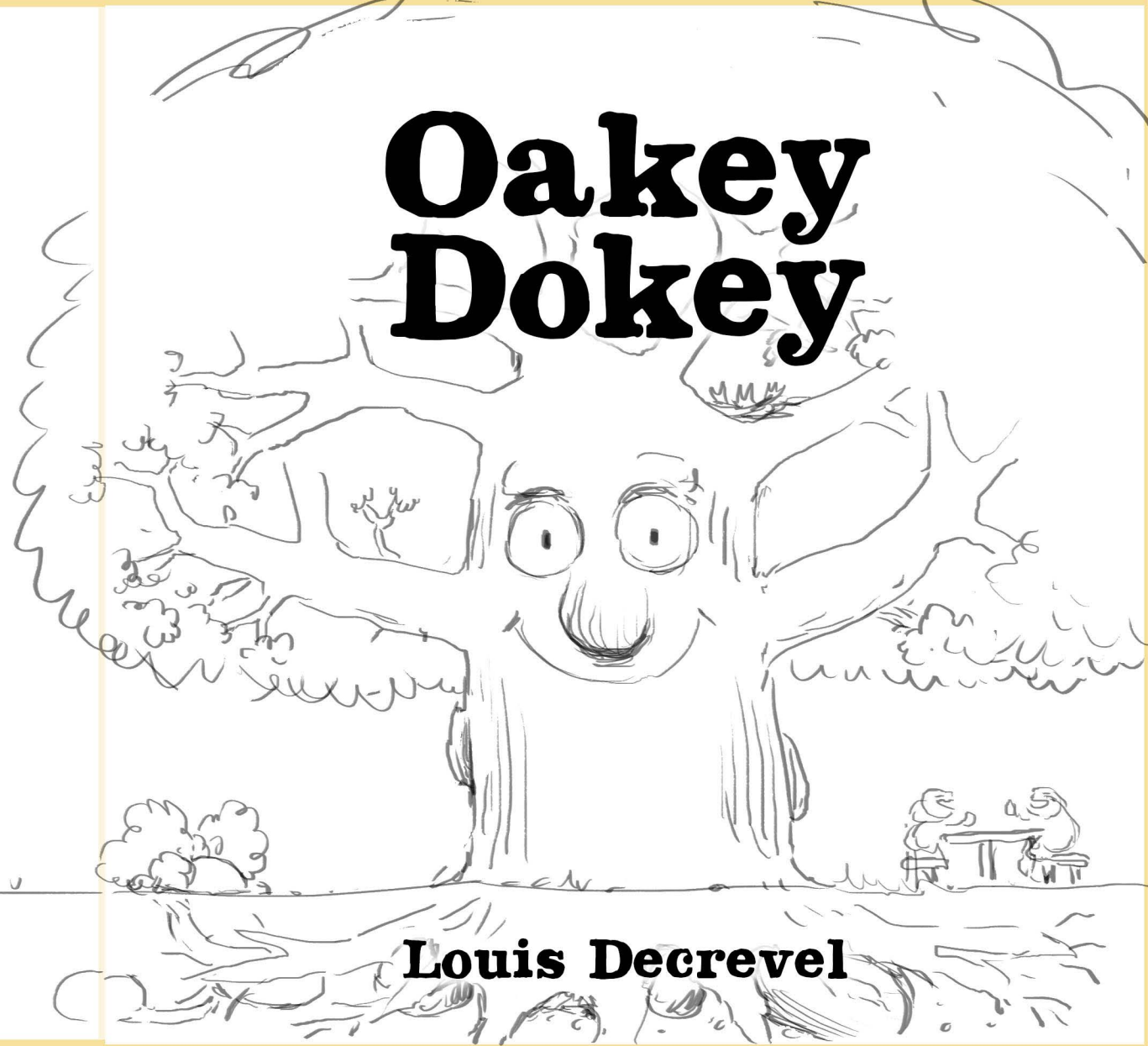

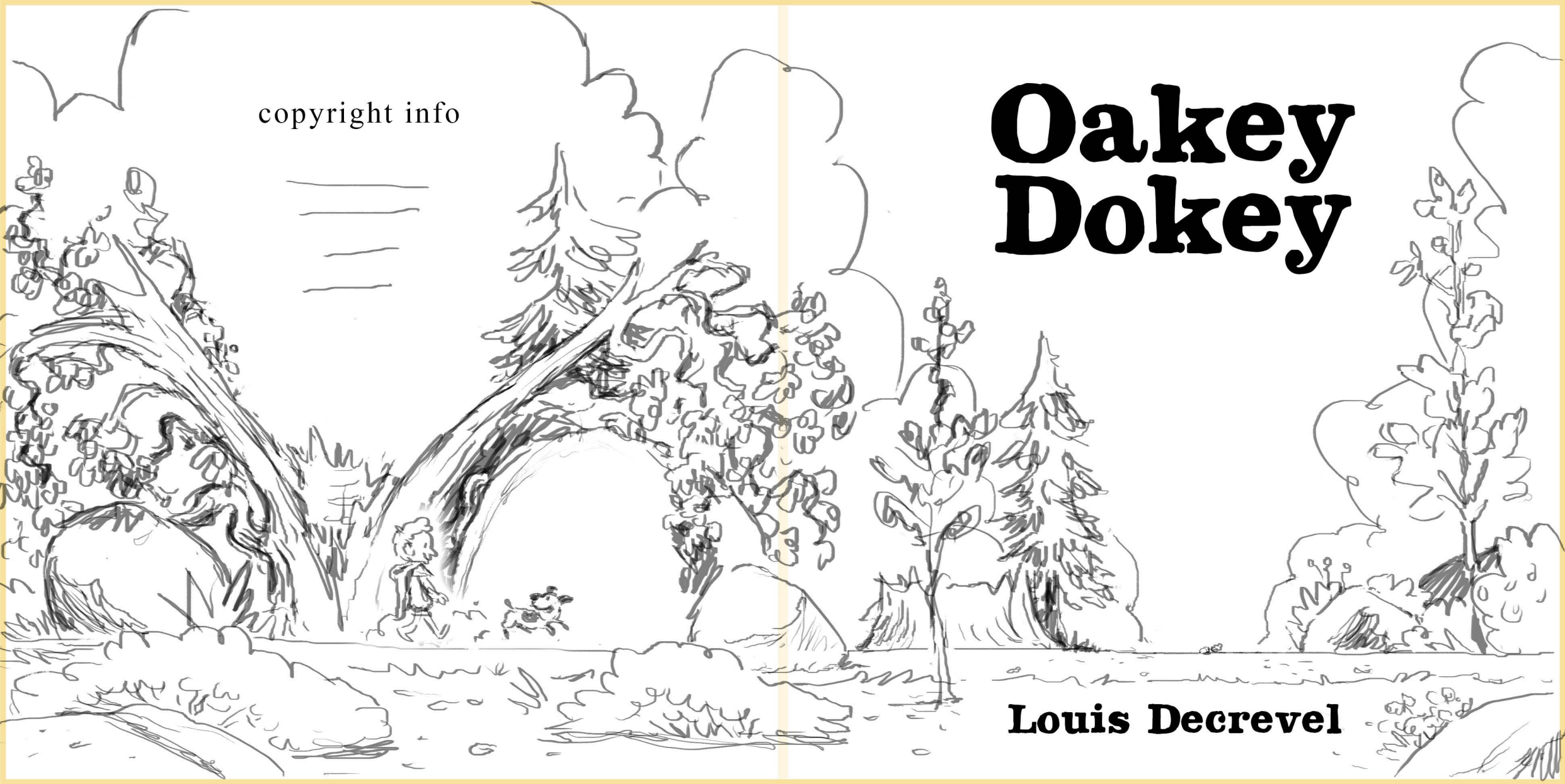

ACORN!

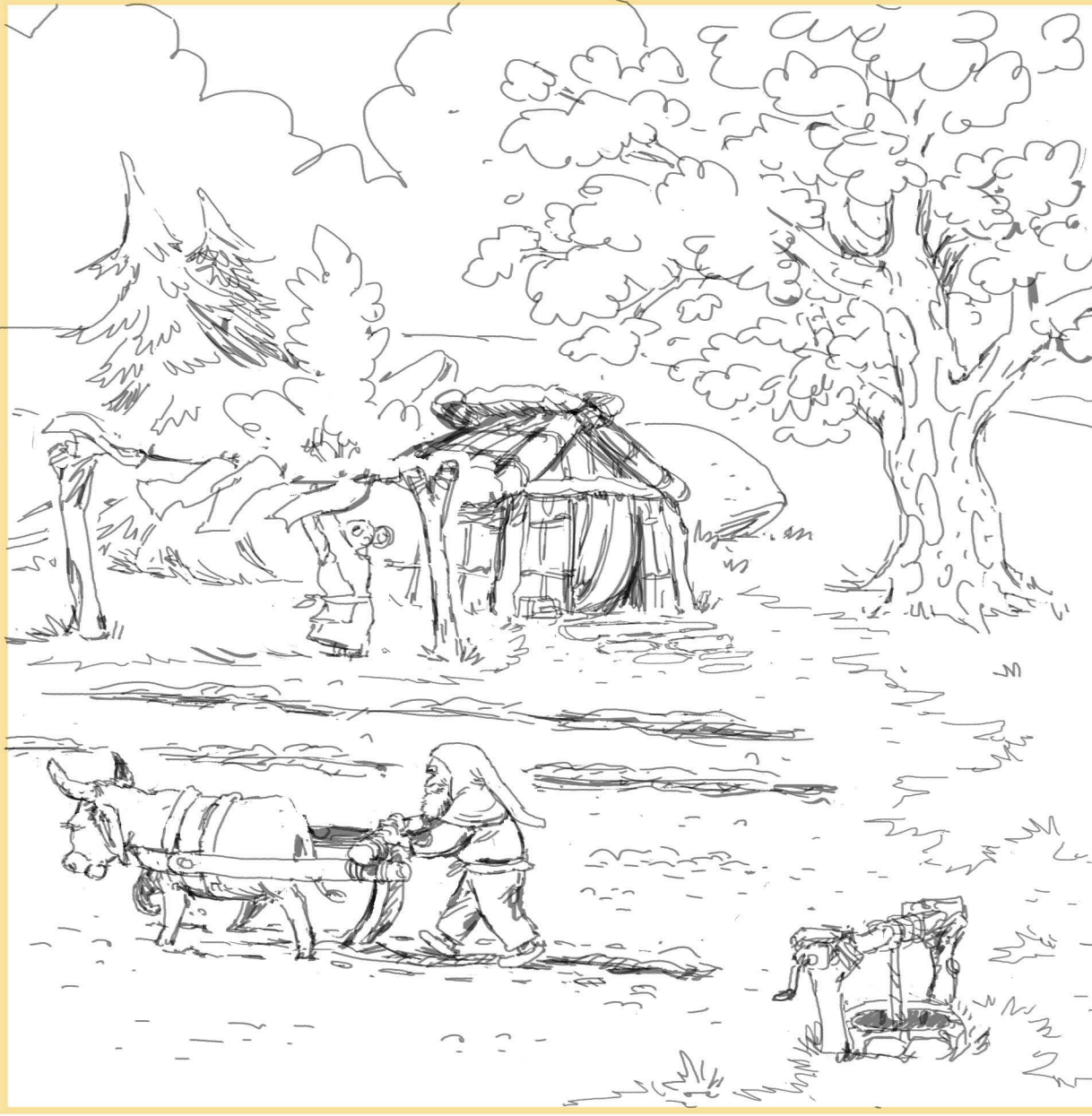
said a child.

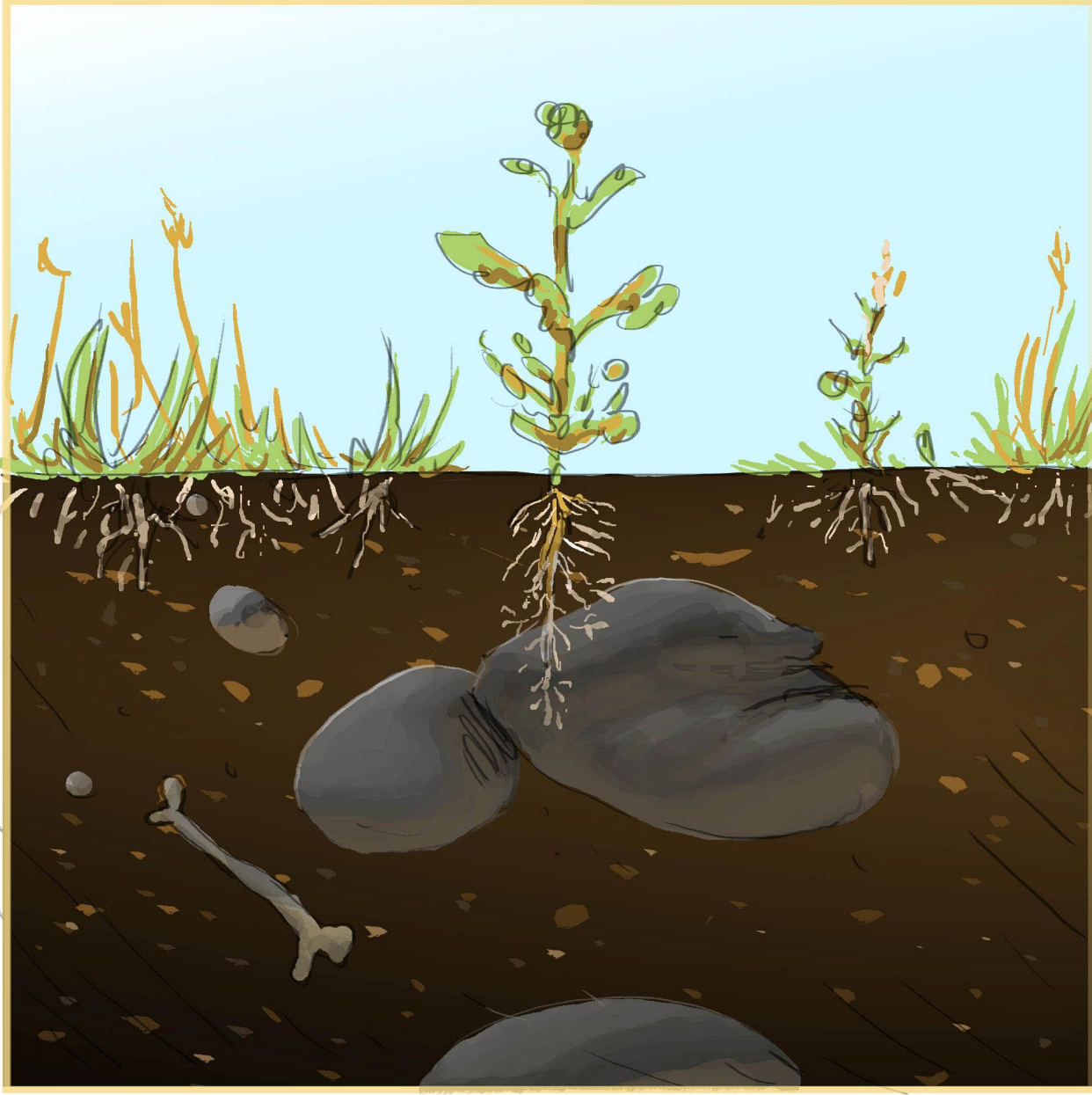


I SHALL PLANT YOU IN

and slid into the child's pocket.





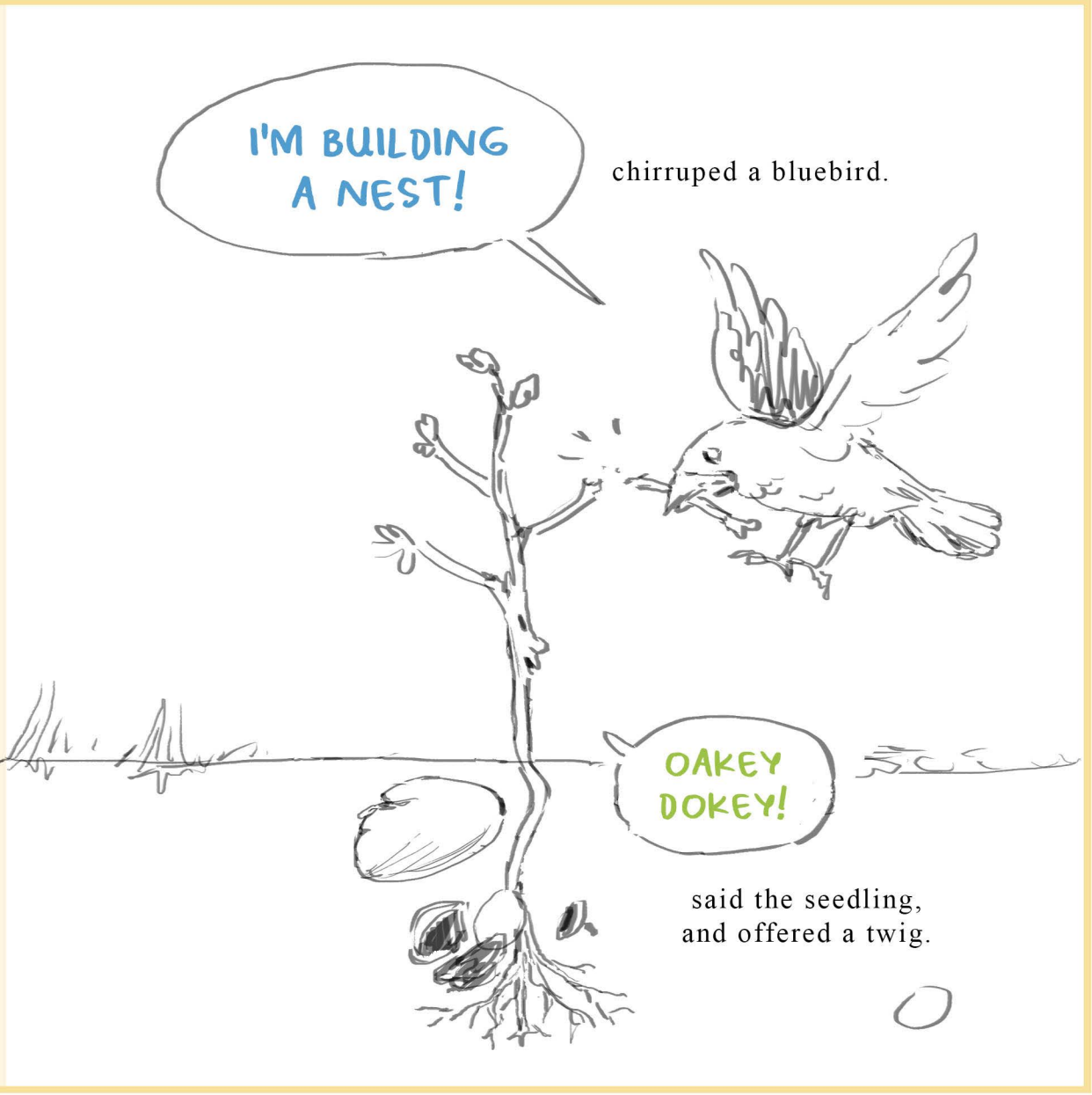
HEY

chirruped a bluebird.

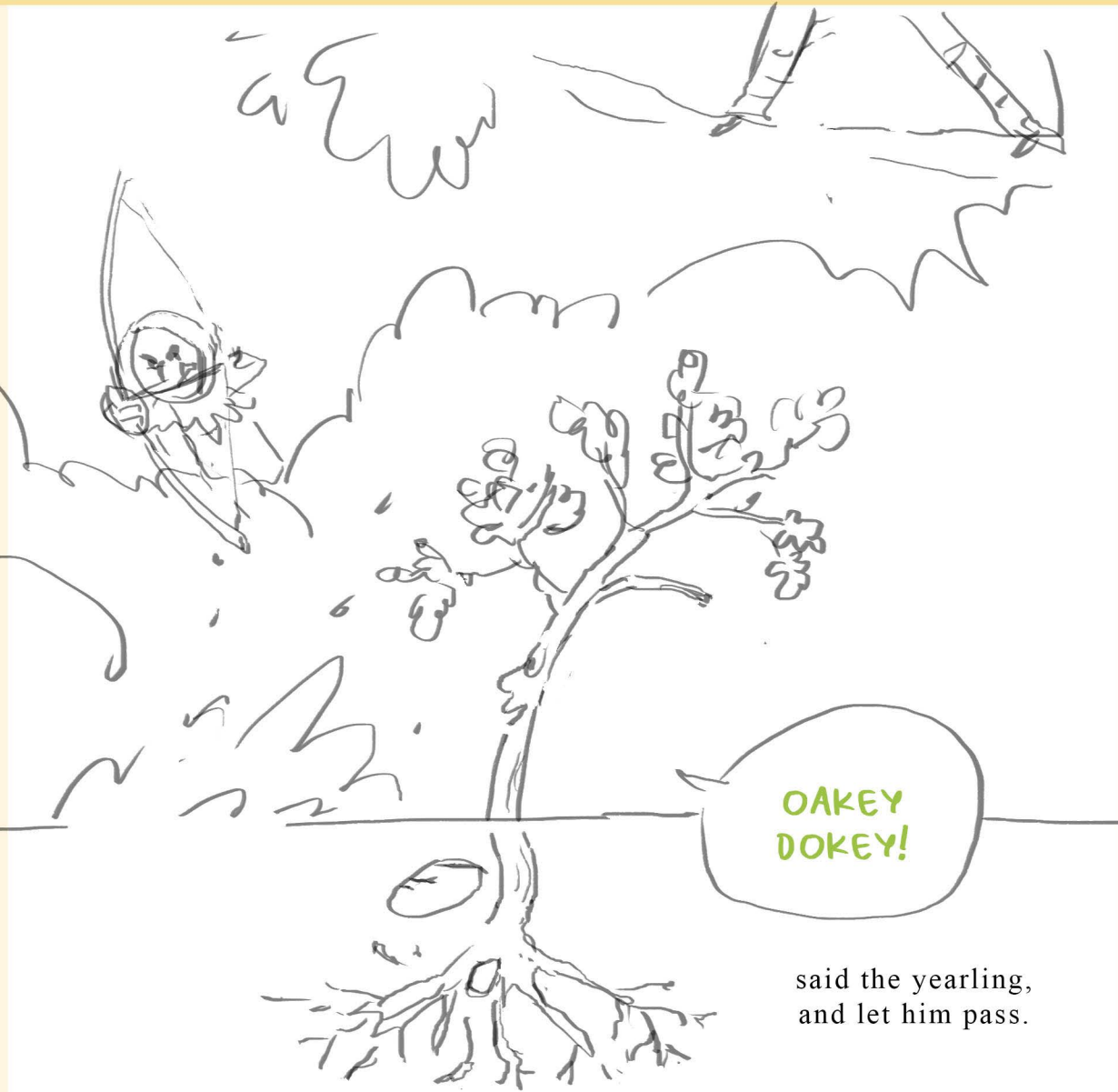
OAKY

and bowed down.



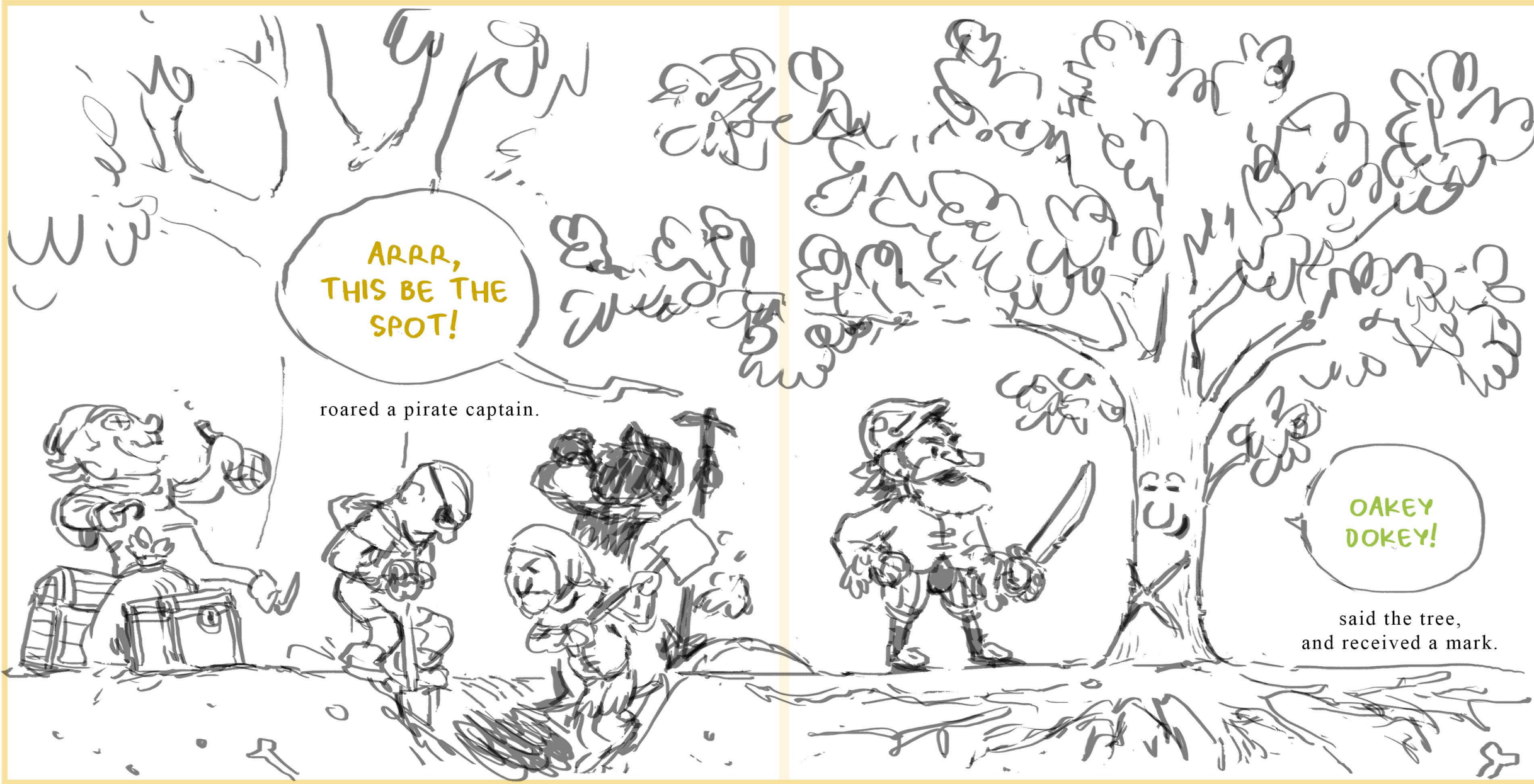
WE'RE

OAKY

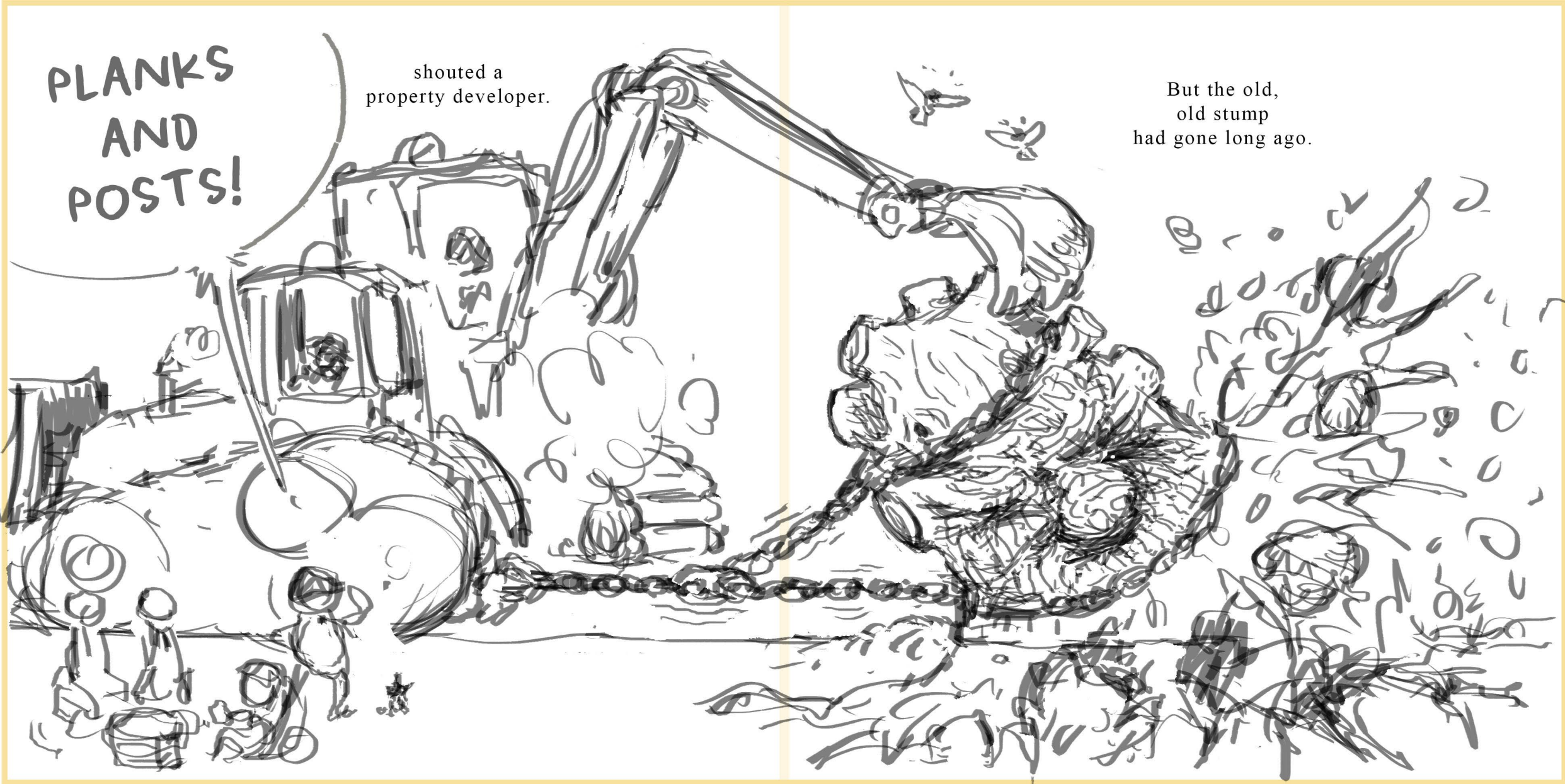

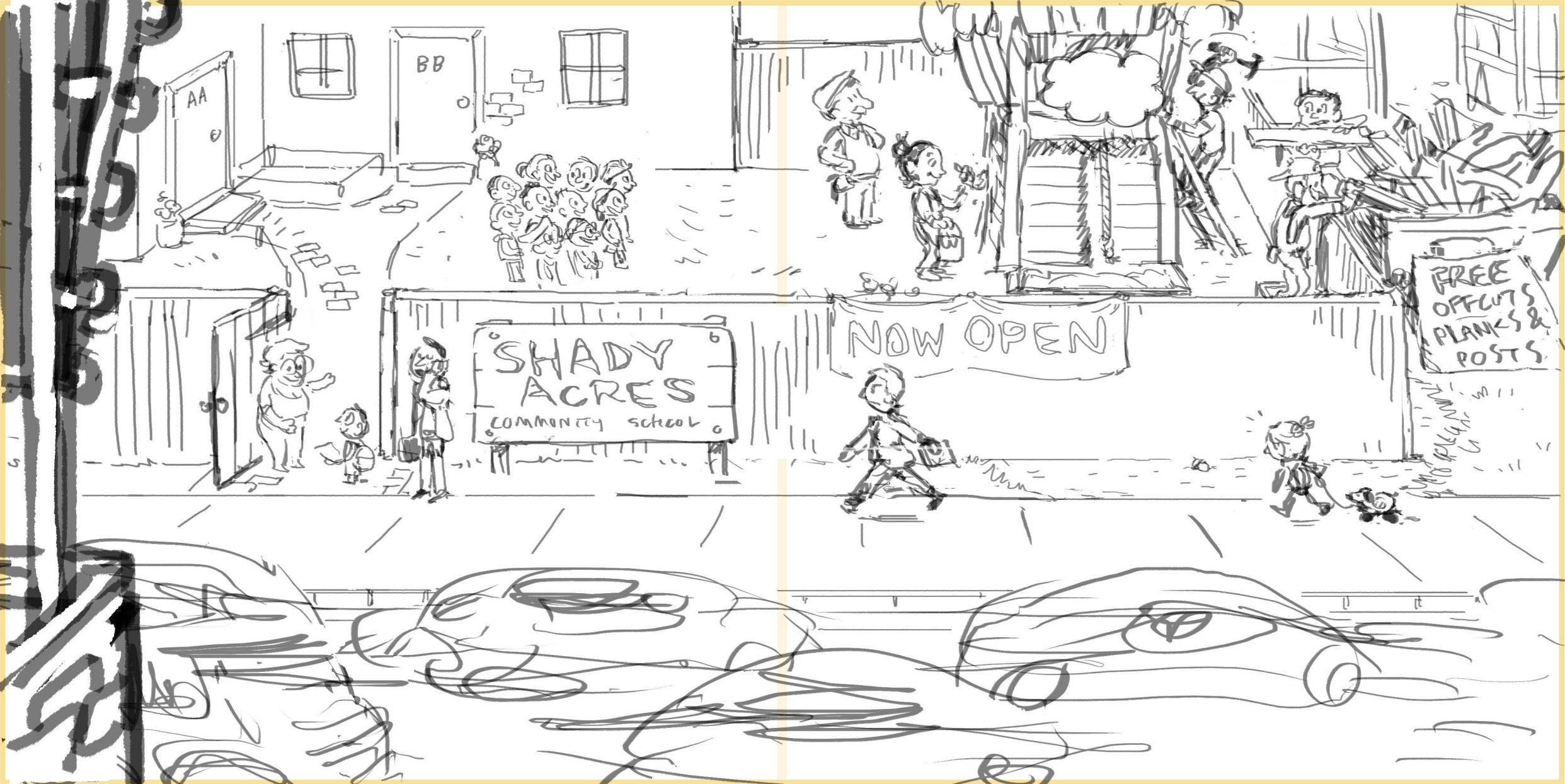
said the ancient one, and bent his weary neck.
